

## **Maths** fractions



Imagine you are to going to hold a picnic for the class. There will be 25 children and five adults attending. They can choose to have one stuffed pepper or two corn on the cob.

- Q1. 20 people want stuffed peppers. What fraction of those attending the picnic want stuffed peppers?
- Q2. Of those wanting stuffed peppers 1/5 don't want side salad. How many don't want side salad?
- Q3. 0.8 of the children want corn on the cob. How many children will have corn on the cob?
- Q4. If the farmer's corn cob field measures 200m by 200m, how many square metres is this?
